- Property must be located in the Central Business District and engage with professional architectural services
- Matching grants up to \$50,000, or 50% of the total project cost, to building owners or business owners
- Applications are subject to a \$250 administrative fee and are reviewed on the last Wednesday of each month by the Paris to Pittsburgh Advisory Committee
- Paris to Pittsburgh **grants can leverage funds** available through Urban Redevelopment Authority and Landmarks Community Capital Corporation grant and loan programs
