

DOWNTOWN WASTE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION



Get you up to speed on what you need to know when it comes to refuse and recycling collection.

IMPORTANT TO KNOW:

- If you own commercial property or large residential buildings (exceeding 6 units), you are responsible for contracting waste removal services. You can find a list of commercial waste and recycling haulers on the City's website
- Smaller residential buildings of 5 units or less are still served by municipal pick-ups.
- Private haulers have their own collection schedule and requirements.

CITY PRIVATE HAULING REGULATIONS:

Waste must be placed in a neat and sanitary manner. That means:

- Waste must be stored separately in durable, watertight containers with close-fitting lids.
- Bags or trash items can not be placed directly on the sidewalk.
- Cans must not block any block the sidewalk and must leave at least 5 ft. of space for pedestrians.

Property Owners / Managers must also:

- Store the property's cans less than 30 ft. from the residence or establishment.
- Label dumpsters and/or containers with the associated establishment name and/or address
- Inform tenants about the details of their hauling service AND these regulations for placing trash.
