Live entertainment will be featured each week and the Market has availability for a wide variety of local, handmade artisans to participate throughout the season.

Dates: Saturdays - June 22 – October 26, 2024, in Market Square

June - August: 5:00pm – 10:00pm

September: 4:00pm - 9:00pm

October: 3:00pm - 8:00pm

Vendor Classification & Pricing:	10x10' space	10x20' space
MERCHANDISE VENDOR: Non-food items, hand crafts. Examples: jewelry, souvenirs, trinkets, pottery, glassworks, beauty products etc.	\$50/market	\$100/market
PROCESSED FOOD VENDOR: Packaged snacks & desserts, misc. food products. Examples: jarred jams and sauces, jerky, sweets.	\$50/market	\$100/market
PREPARED FOOD VENDOR: Ready-to-eat meals and/or hot foods.	\$70/market	\$140/market
ALCOHOL VENDOR: Bottled alcohol products of any type: beer, wine, cider, mead, spirits, etc. Products should not be available in state stores. Bottle sales and samples only, onsite consumption not permitted.	\$75/market	\$150/market

Vendor Qualifications:

- Vendors may apply to attend on select dates, subject to availability
- Applications received prior to April 30, 2024 will be reviewed for a first wave of acceptance.
- After April 30, applications must be submitted a minimum of two weeks prior to the first requested date and will be considered on a rolling basis as capacity permits.
- Vendors are required to provide their own tents, weights, lights, and all other materials essential to their setup
- Vendors in PDP markets must use paper bags after sales are made in compliance with the City's [guidelines](#).
- All accepted Vendors must provide a Certificate of Insurance naming PDP and City of Pittsburgh as additionally insured by the provided deadline.
- Vendors must accept the terms of the [Vendor Participation Agreement](#)
- Alcohol Vendors must comply with all the regulations stated in the [Alcohol Vendor Agreement](#)
