Vendor Chalet Pricing:

10x10 Chalet	\$7,100 / full season
10x16 Chalet	\$11,700 / full season
Part-Time Vendor Rate	\$350 per day 3 day minimum

Vendor Qualifications:

- Chalet specifications are available upon request
- Accepted Vendors are provided with limited power and heaters
- Part-time Vendors – may request specific dates, subject to approval and availability
- Vendors must comply with all regulations stated in the Vendor Participation Agreement
- A complete list of the products you intend to offer at the Market must be submitted
- All accepted Vendors must provide Certificates of Insurance to PDP
- The criteria for vendor selection will include, but not be limited to: quality, uniqueness, pricing, and consistency with the Holiday Season.
- Applications will be considered on a rolling basis as capacity permits.

Applications due by August 17, 2026.
